

Case Study 1

Sam is nine years old. He has had problems since birth: his mother said that doctors described his condition as his “brain being wired back-to-front”. Sam has always suffered regular seizures, usually controlled by medication.

Shortly after moving home to an idyllic barn conversion in Kent, Sam’s seizures became much worse. They increased from one a year to clusters of approximately 10-15 seizures every three days, and more violent in nature. After adjusting his medication and “trying everything” including cranial osteopathy and other therapies with no results, his mother suspected that the change in his condition might be location linked and contacted Lifespace.

Lifespace surveyed their new home, identified a geopathic stress line running through the property, and deactivated the line by stopping the flow. In addition it was recommended that the consumer unit cupboard that projected into one corner of Sam’s bedroom to be lined with lead.

After two weeks, Lifespace contacted Sam’s mother. Apart from one slight petit mal, he had experienced *no seizures* since the day of the survey; his “terribly grey” pallor had gone and he now had colour in his complexion; his digestive system was once more functioning well; and his communication skills had improved. His physician was impressed both with his progress and appearance.

After three months, Lifespace once more contacted the family. Sam’s condition was described as “brilliant”. Apart from one cluster of seizures brought on by a stomach bug coupled with the drugs used to treat it, Sam had had *no more* seizures. This had enabled his mother to reduce his epilepsy medication: one dosage has been reduced from six to two, and the other medication reduced from three to two.

After five months Sam’s mother told us that she has been able to take Sam completely off his medication. She is understandably thrilled and said a “whole new little boy has emerged”.

Lifespace is continuing to monitor Sam’s condition.
